SECTION III: STUDENT POLICY 3040



Self-Administration of Prescribed Medication

Insight School of Oklahoma shall permit the self-administration of inhaled asthma medication by a student for treatment of asthma, the self-administration of anaphylaxis medication by a student for treatment of anaphylaxis and the self-administration of replacement pancreatic enzymes by a student for treatment of cystic fibrosis at all in person, school sponsored events, including but not limited to state testing, outings, prom and graduation, when deemed necessary by a licensed physician. The parent or legal guardian is responsible for submitting the Medication Authorization Form to the school and supplying an emergency supply of the medication. A student may self-administer prescribed medication if the self-carry/self-administration section on the Medication Authorization Form has been completed by a parent/guardian and the physician. Students with an approved Medication Authorization Form on file shall be permitted to possess and use a prescribed inhaler, replacement pancreatic enzyme or anaphylaxis medication including, but not limited to, an Epinephrine injector at all times. The Medication Authorization Form will be valid for the current school year.
