SECTION III: STUDENT POLICIES 3430

Transportation

The Board of Education (the "Board") of Insight School of Oklahoma (the "School") acknowledges the challenges

that families and students may confront concerning transportation to and from School and for extracurricular

activities to encourage community involvement. In an effort to ensure equitable opportunities for all students,

the Board authorizes transportation services to qualifying students that request transportation for these

purposes.

Extra-curricular activities are defined herein to include School field trips, testing, community involvement

events, such as town-hall meetings, etc., and other School sanctioned events for students that request

transportation services so long as the Oklahoma State Department of Education ("OSDE") authorizes

transportation funding for the School. The School intends to provide these transportation services by using City

bus passes, Uber/Lyft, or other similar transportation service providers, and bus rentals for specific School

sanctioned activities as determined by the Executive Director. Due to budgetary constraints, the School may not

be able to provide these transportation services should the OSDE fail to authorize transportation funding for

the School.

The Board directs the Executive Director to prepare the appropriate forms for students to request

transportation services and to take the steps necessary to ensure transportation services are provided as set

forth herein, and to take the steps necessary to request transportation funding from the OSDE.
